Important Updates and Actions required relating to January 2020 Microsoft Security Patch Updates for Windows 10 (KB4534271)

The January 2020 Microsoft Security Update (KB4534271) addressed several potential vulnerabilities. If left unpatched, one of these vulnerabilities (CVE-2020-0601 | Windows CryptoAPI Spoofing Vulnerability) exposes signed files, TLS Communications and other uses of certificates to be compromised.

NCR strongly recommends that all customers on Windows 10 test the January 2020 Microsoft Security Patch Updates (KB4534271) as soon as possible.

Additionally, we also recommend that all customers apply the complete set of [Best Practices for the protection from Logical attacks which include our "15 Rules"](#).

Both the patch and the alignment with our [Best Practice recommendations](#) are required to mitigate the risk from these vulnerabilities.
